MORNING REMINDERS

ATTENDANCE

- Regular school attendance is essential if children are to achieve their full potential.
- We believe that regular school attendance is the key to enabling children to maximise the educational opportunities available to them and become emotionally resilient, confident and competent adults who can realise their full potential and make a positive contribution to their community.
- As a school, we class 96% or above attendance as good attendance. Attendance is monitored regularly and support is available as needed.

BREAK AND LUNCHTIMES

- Fruit is available in the dining hall at break times. Children can bring in their own healthy snack.
- Hot dinners are available to children when requested and paid for in advance. They are also able to have packed lunches.
- Healthy eating is important at our school; sandwiches, fruit or vegetables, yoghurt and a small biscuit is ample in a packed lunch. We are a nut free school.



IN THE CLASSROOM

- Rewards Marbles towards a whole class treat, verbal praise, certificates in weekly sharing assemblies, desk guest (toy fox), star of the week, proud of you tickets and Dojos.

<u>UNIFORM</u>

- Clothing should be clearly labelled
- PE kit needs to be worn to school on Tuesdays and Fridays
- Long hair should be tied up using plain hairbands and clips
- Earrings must be plain studs and only one in each ear. These should be taped on PE days.



COMMUNICATION

- Reading diaries will be checked by an adult in school if you write a message in there, make sure your child lets us know.
- There is always a teacher on duty at the start of the day.
- Parents can always speak to me at the end of the day or get a message to me through the office.
- Do we have your up-to-date contact details?
- Parent Evenings are being held on the 20th and 21st of November and the 12th and 13th of March.



HOMEWORK IN YEAR 1

- Reading is an incredibly important skill for children to have and, as always, practice makes perfect! Please try to read with your child every night and record it in their reading diary.
- A piece of Maths and/or English homework will be set on a Friday. This work is due in on the following Wednesday. These tasks will be appropriate for your child and should only take 20 minutes each. They may also have a handwriting letter to practice. This will be written in their homework books.

- Grammar and punctuation teaching is implemented throughout English lessons.
- Handwriting is taught using the Kinetic Letters scheme.



READING

- We are continually assessing children's reading to ensure they are at the correct level.
- If you would like to be a reading helper or would like support with reading strategies for your child, please get in touch.
- Please encourage your child to read at home to develop their love of reading.
