What is Child Protection about?

The adults who work in our school believe that your health, safety and welfare are very important. We respect all children and help to protect your rights. All the adults do their best to make sure you make good progress in your learning. We teach children how to recognise risks in different situations and how to protect themselves and stay safe.

How will we try to protect children?

We will try to provide a safe environment for our children to learn in. We want to help to make sure that all children are safe – at home as well as at school. We think it is important for our children to know where to get help if they are worried or unhappy about something.

Don't keep a secret if...

- Someone is bullying you.
- Someone is saying funny things to you that you do not like or it upsets you.
- Someone is touching you in places you know is wrong.
- Someone is trying to give you tablets, cigarettes, drugs or alcohol.
- Someone is hitting you or hurting you.
- Someone is sending unkind messages to your phone, computer or game console.

Do you need to talk?

You can talk to any adult in school if you need to. Mrs. Byron, Mrs. Byer, Mrs Khawaja, Mrs Irvine and Mrs Dempsey have a special job to make sure everyone feels happy and safe in our school; you can always talk to them if you would like to.
